GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

State policy requires that students earn a minimum of 24 credits in grades 9–12. Seniors must meet the following requirements to graduate from a Polk County public high school:

1. Meet the course requirements outlined above.
2. Pass the Florida Comprehensive Assessment Test, or obtain an approved ACT or SAT concordant score.
3. Achieve a 2.0 unweighted grade point average for grades 9–12.

CURRICULUM

Lake Region High School offers a rotating block curriculum. Courses are composed of six ninety minute block classes and one regular sixty-six minute class. Students attend three block classes and the regular class daily. There are two semesters per year. Each semester is eighteen weeks in length. Students may earn one-half credit per course for each semester.

Advanced Placement courses are offered in English, art, foreign language, science, social studies and math. Honors, or college preparatory courses, are offered in English, math, science, social studies, foreign languages, art and music.

Additional programs available to the student body are college early admissions, dual enrollment, exceptional student education, technology education, virtual school, Nova Net and Penn Foster.

Ninth grade students are enrolled in the Lake Region Freshmen Success Academy. Selected sophomore students are enrolled in the Tenth Grade Academy.

CLASS OF 2010

For the class of 2010 14.3% of graduating seniors scored 3 or higher on at least one AP exam during high school. Forty-one per cent of graduating seniors earned a mean SAT score of 483 on the critical reading section, 493 on the mathematics section and 479 on the writing section. Fifty-seven per cent of graduating seniors earned an average ACT score of 16.4 on the English section, 18.9 on the mathematics section, 18.1 on the reading section, 17.6 on the science section and a composite score of 17.9. The class of 2010 sent approximately 60% of graduating seniors to either two (30%) or four (30%) year colleges and universities.

Central Polk County is located 45 miles southwest of Orlando and 50 miles east of Tampa.

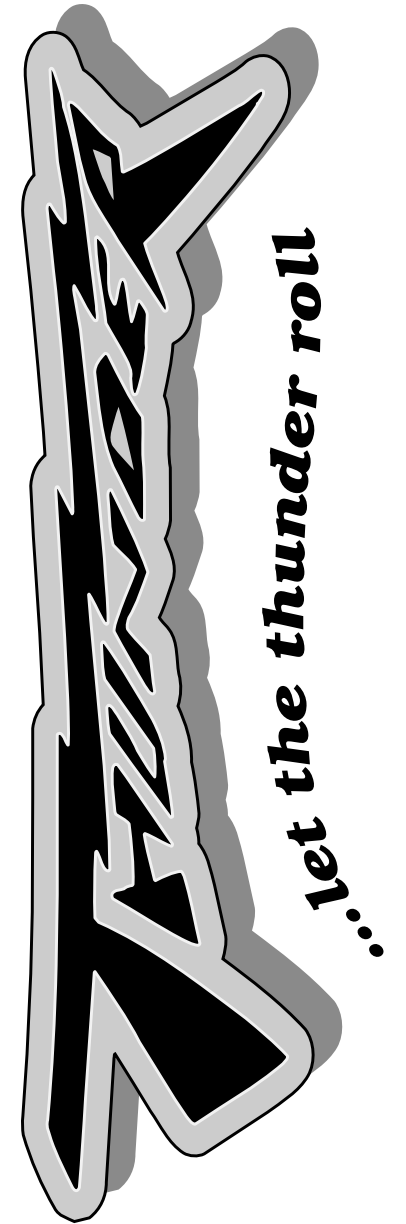
SCHOOL
